



25 Types of Christ from the Old Testament

Adam	The first man, whose actions brought sin/death, whereas Christ is the "last Adam" bringing righteousness/life
Eve	Named "the mother of all living" as the source of natural life; Christ is the source of eternal life for the new creation.
Enoch	A man who walked faithfully with God and was taken up to heaven without dying; Christ walked perfectly with God and ascended bodily into heaven.
Noah	A "second Adam" who served as the head of a new humanity after the flood; Christ is the true Head of a new, redeemed humanity.
Melchizedek	A king-priest without recorded genealogy, offering bread and wine
Abraham	A father willing to sacrifice his only beloved son; God the Father is the ultimate Father who offered His only Son, Jesus, as a sacrifice for the world.
Sarah	The mother of the child of promise who laughed at the impossible; Christ is the promised seed who brings joy through the impossible miracle of the resurrection.
Isaac	The beloved son of promise, obedient to his father, offered as a sacrifice
Rebekah	A bride chosen from a far country who left her home to join her bridegroom; the Church is the bride of Christ, called out of the world to be united with Him.
Jacob	The "chosen one" whose name was changed to Israel; Christ is the true, perfect Israel who represents and gives birth to the Church.
Rachel	Represented the "favored" but suffering wife who waited long for her children; Christ represents the favored Son who waited for the appointed time to bring many sons to glory.
Joseph	A beloved son who was betrayed by his brothers, sold for silver, suffered unjustly, and was exalted to save many
Moses	A prophet and mediator who delivered Israel from slavery

Joshua	Led God's people into the physical Promised Land; Christ (whose name in Hebrew is also Yeshua) leads His people into eternal rest.
David	The shepherd-king who defeats Israel's enemies
Jonathan	A king's son who gave up his right to the throne out of love for David; Christ laid aside His heavenly glory and "emptied Himself" out of love for His people.
Abigail	An intelligent woman who acted as a mediator to turn away David's righteous anger; Christ is our perfect Mediator who turns away divine judgment through His wisdom and intercession.
Hannah	A woman who suffered in silence but was "raised up" by God to give birth to a prophet; Christ was the humble servant raised up to be the ultimate Prophet and King.
Elijah	A prophet taken up into heaven in a whirlwind; Christ ascended into heaven after completing His ministry on earth.
Deborah	A judge and prophetess who led Israel to victory when men were afraid; Christ is our Leader and Prophet who secures victory over our spiritual enemies.
Isaiah	A prophet who volunteered to be sent by God, saying, "Here am I. Send me!"; Christ is the eternal Son who willingly came into the world to do the Father's will and accomplish our salvation.
Job	A blameless and upright man who was handed over to the adversary to be tested; Christ was the only truly sinless man who was led into the wilderness and to the cross to be tempted and tested by the devil.
Esther	A queen who risked her life to intercede for her people before the king; Christ entered the presence of God at the risk—and cost—of His life to save His people from destruction.
Daniel	A righteous man thrown into a den of lions and emerge untouched; Christ was cast into the "den" of death and emerged victorious through the resurrection.
Ruth	A foreigner who lived in poverty but was redeemed and brought into the royal line; Christ redeems the "outsiders" and makes them heirs to His kingdom.
